



Services Provided in 2011

Addiction Treatment and Prevention – Detoxification, Residential Treatment, Outpatient Treatment, Recovery Support, Intervention, Prevention and Education Services

982 individuals spent 2,181 days in detoxification

722 individuals spent 5,131 days in residential treatment

Clients participated in 11,688 individual and group counseling sessions for substance abuse

2,619 individuals were served in addiction treatment services

1,500 people participated in prevention activities

Behavioral Health Services for School Aged Children – Intensive home/community-based and outpatient services for children and their families with mental health issues.

286 children participated in Screening and Assessments

185 families participated in on-going treatment. 61 families completed treatment.

Children’s Advocacy Center – Compassionate, specialized care for children who are victims of sexual or physical abuse.

135 investigative/disclosure interviews were conducted with children

91 children or family members received an assessment

228 families received court support

203 children and family members received ongoing mental health treatment

466 individuals received referrals for community services

Infant and Parent Services Programs – In-home support for families with young children, including concrete assistance, developmental guidance, problem solving, supportive counseling, observation and assessment, and parent-child psychotherapy.

1851 families were screened and assessed county wide

1210 home visits provided to families

57 families assessed and enrolled in the Early Intervention Program for home based services

436 families assessed and enrolled in Parents as Partners in Prevention Program
