Services Provided in 2010

Addiction Treatment and Prevention – *Detoxification, Residential Treatment, Outpatient Treatment, Recovery Support, Intervention, Prevention and Education Services*

- 968 individuals spent 2,164 days in detoxification
- 648 individuals spent 4,469 days in residential treatment
- Clients participated in 11,454 individual and group counseling sessions for substance abuse
- 2,588 individuals were served in addiction treatment services
- 1,500 people participated in prevention activities

Behavioral Health Services for School Aged Children – *Intensive home-based services for children and their families with mental health issues and Outpatient mental health support*

- 272 children participated in Screening and Assessments
- 30 families completed home based services for 2 to 20 hours per week
- 23 families completed community outreach services

Children's Advocacy Center – *Compassionate, specialized care for children who are victims of sexual or physical abuse.*

- 174 investigative/disclosure interviews were conducted with children
- 114 children received an assessment
- 210 families received court support
- 263 children and family members received ongoing mental health treatment
- 282 individuals received referrals for community services

Infant and Parent Services Programs – *In-home support for families with young children, including concrete assistance, developmental guidance, problem solving, supportive counseling, observation and assessment, and parent-child psychotherapy.*

- 1844 families were screened and assessed county wide
- 1764 home visits provided to families
- 67 families assessed and enrolled in the Early Intervention Program for home based services 2 to 20 hours per week.
- 275 families assessed and enrolled in Parents as Partners in Prevention Program
